

Cranial Prosthesis Consultation Checklist

Use this checklist to gather all required medical documents, insurance items, and personal preferences before your scheduled appointment.

1. Essential Medical Documentation

- **Doctor's Prescription:** Must explicitly state the phrase "*Cranial Prosthesis*". Prescriptions listing only a "wig" are frequently rejected by insurance.
- **Diagnosis Details:** Ensure your prescription includes the specific ICD medical diagnosis code matching your hair loss condition (e.g., Alopecia, Chemotherapy side effects).
- **Medical Summary Note:** A brief letter or chart note from your referring physician detailing your diagnosis and the medical necessity of the prosthesis.

2. Insurance & Billing Items

- **Health Insurance Card:** Bring your primary (and secondary, if applicable) health insurance card for coverage validation.
- **Pre-Authorization Form:** If your insurance provider requires pre-approval or a prior authorization number, bring a printed copy.
- **Insurance Claims Guide / Policy Packet:** Any specific reimbursement forms or written guidelines provided by your insurer regarding medical equipment or HCPCS code A9282.

3. Styling & Personal Preferences

- **Reference Photos:** Clear photographs of your hair prior to loss, or images showcasing your desired length, cut, color, and style.
- **Sample Hair Fabric or Swatches:** (Optional) If you have a matching hair sample or a color swatch that you would like to duplicate.
- **Headwear Favorites:** Bring any preferred hats, scarves, or caps you currently use to test fit, comfort, and security during your fitting.
